MINSTER COMMUNITIES

Minster Communities are being set up to address the Churches mission across the Diocese. There is an urgent need to manage things in a different way.

The Diocese is initiating the piloting of the forming of Minster Communities in different areas. One of the identified areas is Coalville.

Each of our PCC's in the Benefice has agreed to be part of the piloting scheme, taking the view that it is better to be a part of it at the beginning and have a major role in shaping what our Minster Community might look like. Being a Minster Community will mean that a designated group of parishes will be brought together collectively for mission, which will be resourced through leadership of a diverse ministry team comprising of Clergy, Licensed Lay Ministers and Head teachers of schools in the designated area.

The Minster Community will operate as follows:

- It will have an Oversight Minister (Ordained Clergy)
- It will promote a Growing Faith in schools, churches and households with a focused minister (Ordained or Lay)
- It will have an Operations Director managing Administration, Buildings work, finances, etc., who will be an Ordained or Lay Minister
- It will have a locally contextually focused minister (Ordained or Lay)

These four main roles will be paid positions.

In addition, there will be an appointed Minister for every Christian community (Ordained, Stipendiary/Non-Stipendiary, Lay) in the designated area.

The Diocese expect the whole exploration process of forming a Minster Community to take between 9-12 months.
