POPPY MAKING

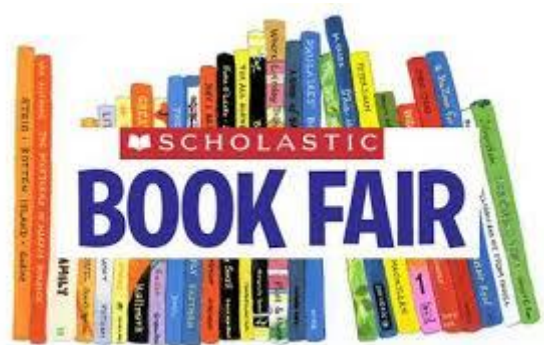
