## INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

- 1. The name of the school is "All Saints Church of England Primary School".
- 2. The school is a Voluntary Controlled school.
- 3. The name of the governing body is The Governing Body of All Saints Church of England Primary School".
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
  - a. four parent governors;
  - b. one Local Authority governor;
  - c. one staff governor;
  - d. one headteacher;
  - e. three foundation governors;
  - f. two co-opted governors.
- 5. The total number of governors will be twelve
- 6. Foundation governors shall be appointed by the Leicester Diocesan Board of Education in consultation with the Parochial Parish Council of Christchurch Coalville
- 7. a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio: the incumbent of the benefice of Coalville with Bardon Hill
  - b) The Diocesan Director of Education and the appropriate Archdeacon shall appoint a foundation governor to act in place of the ex-officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in a) above, in the event that the ex-officio governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
- 8. The Diocesan Director of Education and the appropriate Archdeacon are entitled to request the removal of any ex-officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
- 9. The governing body of All Saints Church of England Primary School, Coalville makes the following statement relating to the character and ethos of the school:-

Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

- 10. A copy of this Instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the Headteacher if not a governor), the trustees of the foundation of the school and the Diocesan Director of Education for Leicester Diocesan Board of Education.
- 11. This Instrument of Government comes into effect on 24<sup>th</sup> June 2015
- This instrument was made by order of the Leicestershire County Council on the alm day of 2015.
